2020 is full of opportunities for members to engage in both statewide and national policy decisions.

This January, Randi Weingarten: President of the American Federation of Teachers, held the AFT Northeastern Regional Meeting in Saratoga Springs. She restated how public education has been under attack since Betsy DeVos became Secretary of Education and the repercussions of this that are being felt throughout the country. This has resulted in the increase in the number of Charter Schools that can access public education funding in New York State (which takes away funding for districts who send students to BOCES). We need to make sure that our voices are heard this election by voting for candidates that support public education.

NYSUT and the AFT are both advocating for 100% participation in the 2020 Census for the same reason. Millions of dollars in Public Education funding will be lost if we do not count every individual in our state. <u>https://</u> nysutcounts.org/ We were encouraged by the statements from our state legislators on BOCES Lobby Day when they pledged their full support for the BOCES bills (more on p.2) in the legislature.

Our local representative, Antonio Delgado, during a visit to CGEC, is also proposing a bill entitled the "Gateways to Careers Act" in the U.S. Assembly. (more on p.1)

Article 5: Negotiations Procedures (p. 8)

"Prior to January 15th of the last year of this Agreement, either party may request the commencement of negotiations with a view towards an agreement to succeed this Agreement."

In January 2020 a request was made to our administration to begin the process of negotiating our next contract. Several meetings have taken place by both the administrative and union teams to author their proposals since that time. Unfortunate events related to the COVID-2019 pandemic have now stalled the process.

NYSUT is not meeting with any of its locals until April 15th, 2020. We will be utilizing email correspondence to finalize our union proposal.

In addition, our schools may need to close for periods of time preventing us from communicating as a team in person.

As a result, we want the membership to know that both the administrative and union teams are ready to proceed once cleared for health and safety reasons. That remains our primary concern for all.

BOCES Lobby Day 2020

Students and staff from CGEC, REC and Sackett Educational Center met with legislators in the Assembly and Sen-

ate Feb. 26th in support of BO-CES Legislation. Students were prepared to speak to the 8 bills proposed in the legislature this session in addition to advocating for the removal of the

BOCES Aid and Special Act Aid from the Foundation Aid in the Governor's proposed budget.

Staff were amazed by the powerful stories students shared, followed by the naming of the bill and the sponsor. Students then elaborated why this bill was so important to them and their program. The adults in the room could not have made as strong an impact.

All Questar III participants were invited to the Assembly Floor by Rep. Chris Tague (a former BOCES CTE graduate) to be present when he proposed his bill citing that CTE Month (February) would become a statewide recognition annually.

NYSUT 2000 COUNTS CENSUS

What is the Census?

The U.S. Constitution requires the Congress to count every person living in the United States every 10 years. This count has been conducted every decade for the past 230 years. The Census counts all residents, including non-citizens and children.

Why is it important?

Information from the Census is used to distribute more than \$700 billion in federal funds for programs such as: Medicaid, Title 1, school lunches, special education and housing assistance and many others. In addition, New York's congressional districts and state Senate and Assembly districts will be redrawn in 2021 based on Census data. Experts project New York could lose one – possibly two – congressional seats, based on population trends and undercounting.



As the response rate increases, our state's share of critical federal funding gets larger.



What is different this year? For the first time, people will be able to

fill out the Census survey online, by telephone or by mail. The Census Bureau will begin sending mail to all residents in the middle of March. The first day you can complete the Census online is March 12. In the following weeks, the bureau will send reminders to households that have not responded, and nonresponders may be contacted at home.

Several populations are at higher risk of being undercounted: children, non-English speakers, immigrants and those without access to the Internet. Some people do not complete the

Census for multiple reasons, including fear and distrust of government; concerns over privacy and security; and general apathy. Our outreach can help allay their concerns.

NYSUT's Plan

- NYSUT encourages local leaders to run member-to-member campaigns about the importance of being counted.
- Develop print and digital materials to engage and educate members.
- NYSUT is working with other unions, community groups and like-minded organizations to spread the message.
- Children were undercounted in 2010. Our work will include curriculum, resources and activities for use in the classroom. NYSUT members can educate our students so that they will ask their parents if they've been counted.
