Welcome to the 2021/2022 school year. Last year we stood together to open our schools safely and to ensure a one year extension to our contract without concessions. We reminded the administration at every opportunity of the good work that our membership was doing and the benefits that our students were receiving as a result. We also reminded them of the difficult circumstances that we work under during normal times and educated them as to how much more difficult those conditions had become. We communicated the reality that we were tired and that the new requirements were not sustainable.

This year we resolve to do more of the same. We have clarified our position with the administration during a Liaison meeting on August 25th. The topics included staff schedules and preps, staffing ratios and shortages, covid protocols, remote instruction, and building readiness among others.

Although the policy around remote instruction has tightened, and we expect far fewer remote students, we know as the year progresses there will be instances of in person students needing to quarantine. We continue talking with the administration to shape what remote instruction will look like. There is however a general agreement that what happened last year can not be repeated.

As the year begins we will continue to advocate for our membership regarding these and other issues. We will once again begin negotiating a new contract, hopefully in October. As you know, the agreed upon extension has expired. We were pleased to have finally reached an agreement with the administration, but believe it should have happened months before it did. We will use this new round of negotiations to "reset" the process and hope that the administration will engage with the same mindset.
